



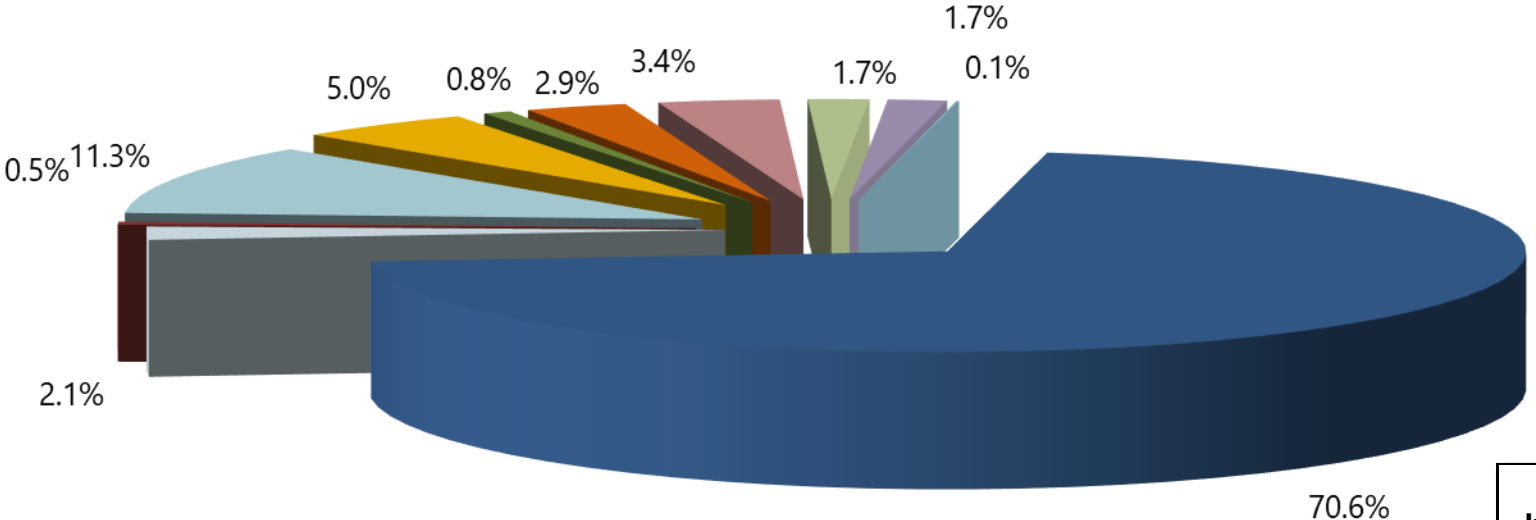

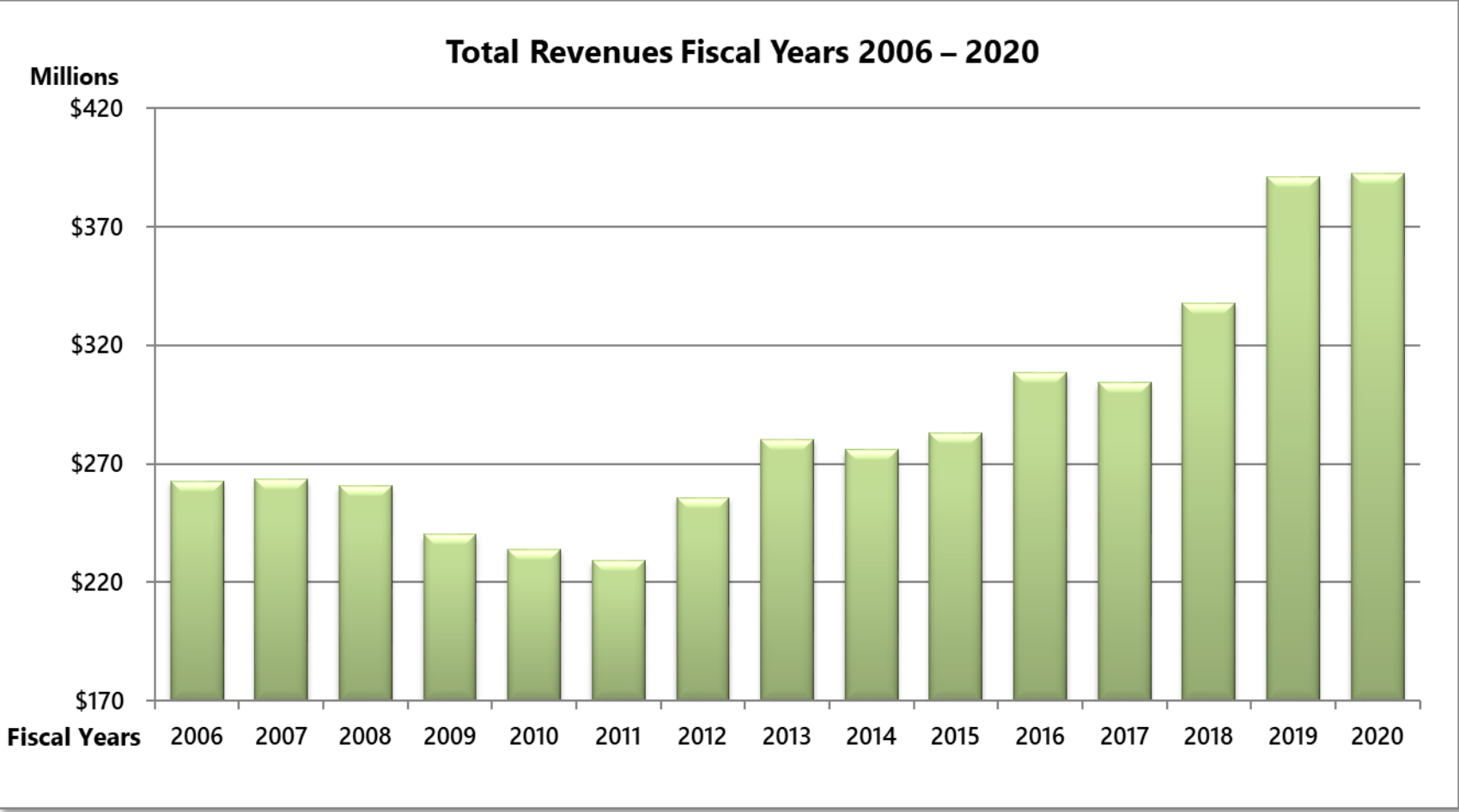

Sales by Game Last 10 Fiscal Years

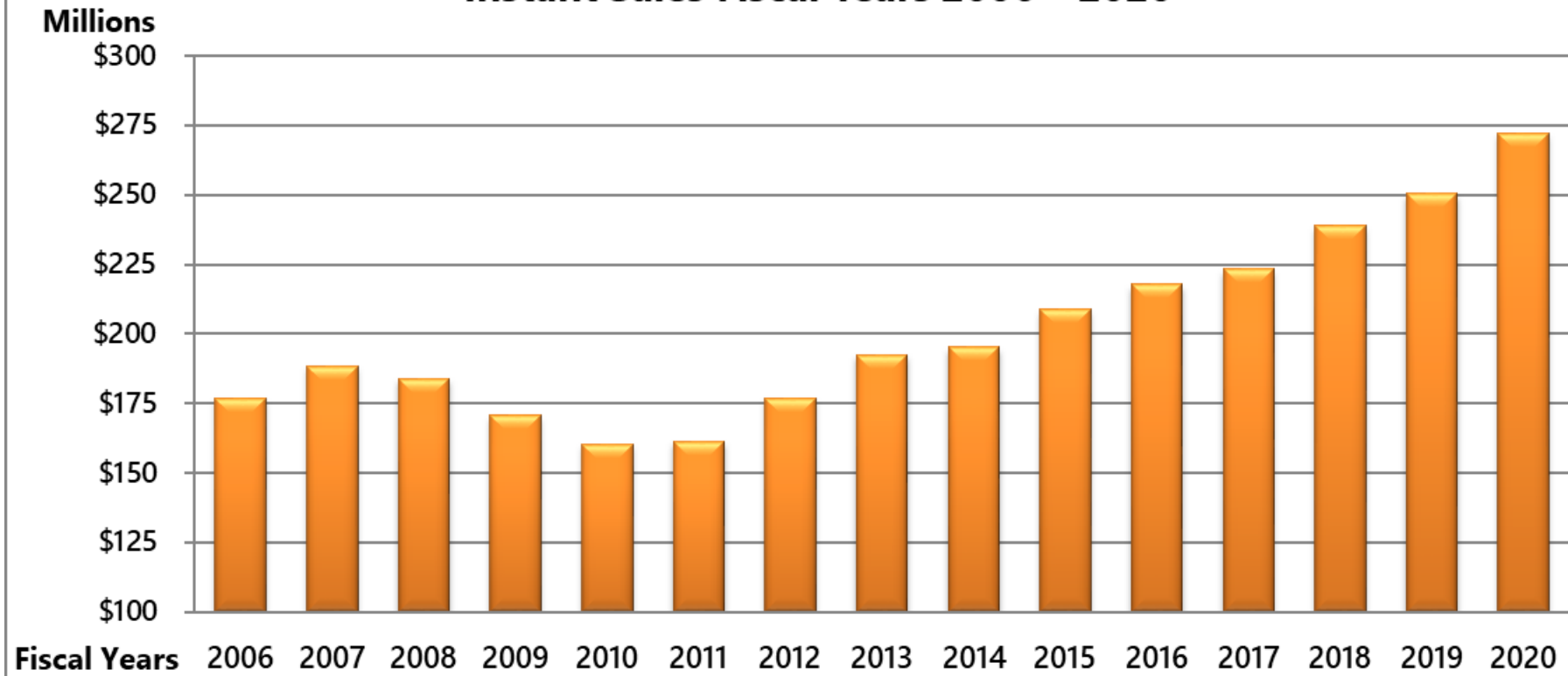

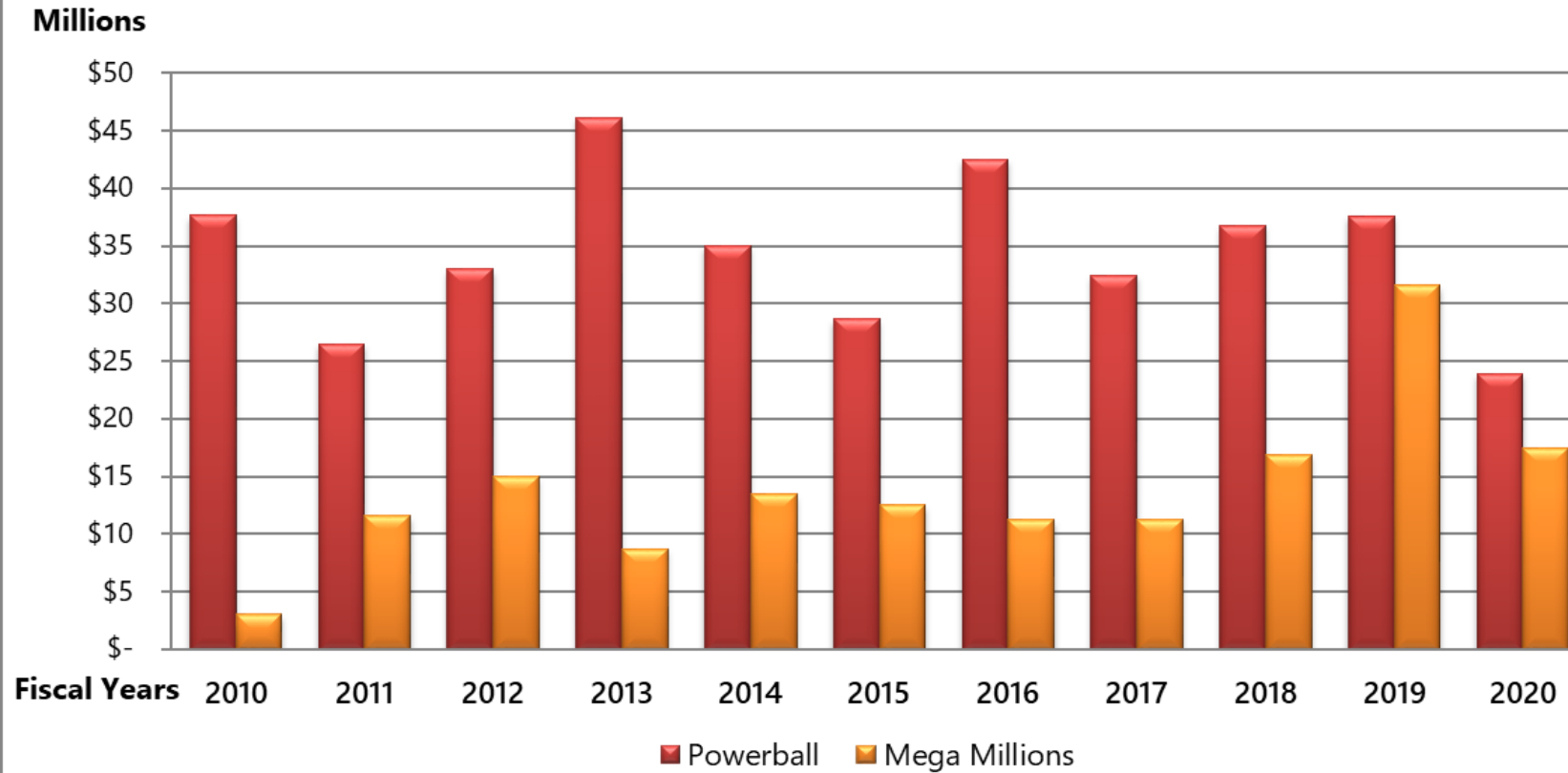

Instant Sales Fiscal Years 2006 – 2020



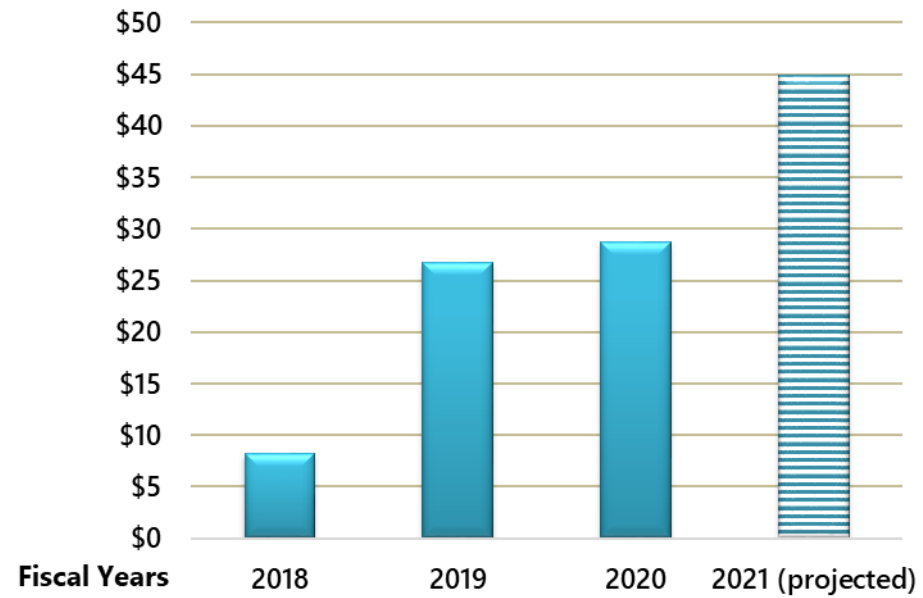
Powerball and Mega Millions* Sales Fiscal Years 2010 – 2020
