Telecommunications Equipment Assistance Program (TEAP)

I have attached for your review a copy of the FY2024 TEAP Annual Report (Governor and Executive Council, October 30, 2024, item #31).

The plan level fees which could/would be assessed regarding account owner's assets within The NH ABLE Plan are listed at <https://savewithable.com/nh/home/plan-benefits.html>, and are as follows.


"The annualized investment costs on assets per investment option range from 0.31% to 0.36%, depending on which investment option(s) you select.

Each Account is charged an Annual Account Maintenance Fee of \$56.00 that is assessed and withdrawn from the Account in the amount of \$14.00 quarterly. If Electronic Delivery is selected, the Annual Account Maintenance Fee is reduced to \$31.00 and assessed at \$7.75 quarterly".

Additionally, there is a \$2.00 monthly fee assessed should the account owner choose the checking account option. The \$2.00 monthly fee is waived should the account owner choose e-delivery of the monthly statements or if there is a monthly balance of \$250.00 in the checking account.
