

Amendment to HB 2-FN-A-LOCAL

1 Amend RSA 266:1, VIII-a and VIII-b as inserted by section 259 of the bill by replacing it with the
2 following:

4 VIII-a. Every new vehicle, with a certificate of origin, excluding commercial motor vehicles,
5 school buses, shall be subject to inspection at the time of initial registration in accordance with
6 paragraph IV, and thereafter prior to the last day of the registered owner's month of birth that
7 occurs not more than 60 months following the date of initial registration.

8 VIII-b. The inspection sticker issued shall retain the originally scheduled expiration date
9 corresponding to the registered owner's month of birth, provided such date does not exceed 60
10 months from the date of initial registration. Notwithstanding paragraph VIII-a, any vehicle
11 registered under this title, except an OHRV, snowmobile, moped, roadable aircraft, or other exempt
12 vehicle, shall be inspected once a year, during the month in which the birth date of the owner is
13 observed, if the owner is a natural person. An inspection sticker shall be valid for the same duration
14 as the vehicle's registration, which shall not exceed 16 months. If the month in which the
15 anniversary of the owner's birth occurs will be one of the next 4 months, an inspection sticker may
16 be issued, with an expiration date of the birth month in the following year, of the first person named
17 on the title application. Nothing in this paragraph shall require any person who has registered and
18 had inspected a vehicle with temporary plates to have the vehicle reinspected upon receipt of
19 permanent motor vehicle plates. An inspection sticker shall not expire when a vehicle is transferred
20 to a licensed dealer.

22 Amend the bill by replacing section 274 with the following:

24 274 Effective Date.

25 I. Section 273 shall take effect upon its passage.

26 II. Sections 253-272 of this act shall take effect January 1, 2026.
