

Amendment to HB 2-FN-A-LOCAL

1 Amend RSA 266:1, VIII-a and VIII-b as inserted by section 259 of the bill by replacing it with the
2 following:

4 VIII-a. Notwithstanding paragraph II, every new vehicle, with a certificate of origin,
5 excluding commercial motor vehicles and school buses, shall be subject to inspection at the time of
6 initial registration in accordance with paragraph IV, and thereafter prior to the last day of the
7 registered owner's month of birth or the date listed in paragraph III, if applicable, that occurs not
8 more than 60 months following the date of initial registration.

9 VIII-b. The inspection sticker issued shall retain the originally scheduled expiration date
10 corresponding to the registered owner's month of birth or the date listed in paragraph III, if
11 applicable, provided such date does not exceed 60 months from the date of initial registration.
12 Following the time period listed in paragraph VIII-a, any vehicle registered under this title, except
13 an OHRV, snowmobile, moped, roadable aircraft, or other exempt vehicle, shall be inspected once a
14 year, during the month in which the birth date of the owner is observed or the date listed in
15 paragraph III, if applicable, if the owner is a natural person. An inspection sticker shall be valid for
16 the same duration as the vehicle's registration, which shall not exceed 16 months. If the month in
17 which the anniversary of the owner's birth occurs will be one of the next 4 months, an inspection
18 sticker may be issued, with an expiration date of the birth month in the following year, of the first
19 person named on the title application. Nothing in this paragraph shall require any person who has
20 registered and had inspected a vehicle with temporary plates to have the vehicle reinspected upon
21 receipt of permanent motor vehicle plates. An inspection sticker shall not expire when a vehicle is
22 transferred to a licensed dealer.

24 Amend the bill by replacing section 274 with the following:

26 274 Effective Date.

27 I. Section 273 shall take effect upon its passage.

28 II. Sections 253-272 of this act shall take effect January 1, 2026.
