

Amendment to SB 456

1 Amend the introductory paragraph of RSA 200:64 as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it  
2 with the following:

4 200:64 Commission Established. There is a commission established to study the health and  
5 well-being of children in the state and to identify the gaps in mental and physical health services  
6 provided to children. The commission shall be administratively attached to the department of  
7 education.

9 Amend RSA 200:64, I(c) as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

11 (c) Seventeen members appointed by the governor, including but not limited to the  
12 following groups:

13

(1) Health care professionals licensed in the state;

14

(2) Medical practitioners licensed in the state specializing in either traditional or  
15 holistic medicine;

16

(3) Child psychologists licensed in the state;

17

(4) Mental health care providers;

18

(5) Teachers certified by the department of education, one of whom is certified in  
19 special education;

20

(6) Dietitians, as defined in RSA 326-H:3;

(7) Members of state or local law enforcement; and

22

(8) Parents of children residing in the state.
