This bill permits a physician to perform breast surgery on a minor if the procedure is at the election of the minor in consultation with her primary care physician.

AN ACT                   relative to breast surgeries for minors.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1           1 Limitations on Breast Surgeries for Minors; Exceptions to Prohibition. Amend RSA 329:53,  
2 II(d) and (e) to read as follows:  
3           (d) The procedure is needed to correct gynecomastia and symptomatic macromastia; [~~or~~]  
4           (e) Treatment of congenital deformities of the breast and/or chest wall[~~;~~]; **or**  
5           **(f) At the election of the minor in consultation with her primary care physician.**  
6           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
