SENATE BILL **117-FN-A**

AN ACT making an appropriation to the department of education to fund the online tutoring program.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill makes an appropriation of \$1,000,000 to the department of education to fund the online tutoring program and requires the department to report on the program annually.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Five

AN ACT making an appropriation to the department of education to fund the online tutoring program.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Appropriation; Department of Education. The sum of \$1,000,000 for the biennium ending
2 June 30, 2027 is hereby appropriated to the department of education to continue the state's online
3 tutoring program. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for said sum out of any money in
4 the treasury not otherwise appropriated. These funds shall be non-lapsing.

5 2 The department shall report annually, beginning June 30, 2026, on the use and effectiveness
6 of the program to the governor, the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of
7 representatives, the chair of the house education policy and administration committee, the chair of
8 the house education finance committee, the chair of the senate education committee, and the chair of
9 the senate education finance committee.

10 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.

METHODOLOGY:

This bill appropriates \$1,000,000 in general funds (non-lapsing) to the Department of Education to fund the online tutoring program. The Department states the online tutoring is being provided statewide in school year 2025-2026 by Khan Academy through the Khanmigo service to NH schools, therefore, there would be no cost to the state in FY 2026. Any costs in FY 2027 and beyond are indeterminable as it is unknown if a free service would be available or if the Department would need to contract with a vendor for services.
