

Amendment to HB 90-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3 1 New Section; Part-Time Teacher; Defined. Amend RSA 189 by inserting after section 39-b the
4 following new section:

5 189:39-c Part-Time Teacher; Defined.

6 I. A part-time teacher is not required to hold a state board of education credential provided
7 that the individual:

8 (a) Works up to 20 hours per week.

9 (b) Seeks a criminal history record check clearance authorization from the department of
10 education as outlined in RSA 189:13-a prior to receiving a final offer of employment.

11 (c) Is employed or contracted as a full time or adjunct faculty member by a university
12 system of New Hampshire or a community college system of New Hampshire member institution.

13 (d) Has expertise or significant professional experience to teach in a subject-area offered
14 by the school or district or an approved college dual or concurrent enrollment course in the high
15 school that has the same quality and rigor as the courses offered on-campus at the sponsoring college
16 or university.

17 II. Part-time teachers shall practice the principles identified in the New Hampshire code of
18 conduct and ethics for educational professionals.

19 III. Any person who has had an educator credential, educator license, or other educator
20 certification revoked under RSA 189:14-c or RSA 189:14-d, or who has been rendered ineligible to be
21 employed as an educator under another provision of law, shall not be eligible to teach under this
22 section.

23 IV. The state board of education shall adopt rules pursuant to RSA 541-A to implement this
24 section.

25 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
