STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT repealing certain committees and commissions.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Offshore Wind Industry Workforce Training Center Committee; Reference Deleted. Amend
2 RSA 12-O:51-a, III to read as follows:

3 III. The committee shall report annually by November 1 to the governor[~~the chair of the~~
4 ~~New Hampshire offshore wind and port development commission under RSA 374-F:10;~~] and the
5 president of the Business and Industry Association.

6 2 Advisory Council on the Education of Children Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing; Reference
7 Deleted. Amend RSA 186-C:35, V to read as follows:

8 V. On or before November 1, the council shall submit an annual report its findings and any
9 recommendations for proposed legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the
10 president of the senate, the education committees in the house and senate, [~~the New Hampshire~~
11 ~~commission on deafness and hearing loss established in RSA 125-Q;~~] the house clerk, the senate
12 clerk, the governor, and the state library.

13 3 Repeal. The following are repealed:

19 energy innovation supporting the offshore wind commission.

20 IV. RSA 12-O:55-a, relative to the commission on demographic trends.

21 V. RSA 12-O:76, relative to the housing champion program advisory committee.

22 VI. RSA 17-J:5, relative to the joint legislative parking garage oversight committee.

23 VII. RSA 72:8-f, relative to the study commission on the assessing of power generation.

24 VIII. RSA 105-D:2-a, relative to the commission to develop recommendations for legislation
25 to establish a single statewide entity to receive complaints alleging misconduct regarding all sworn
26 and elected law enforcement officers.

27 IX. RSA 125-Q, relative to the commission for the deaf and hard of hearing.

28 X. RSA 126-A:17, II(a) and II(b), relative to the house and senate members of the advisory
29 council on child care.

30 XI. RSA 127:12, relative to the commission to study the delivery of public health services
31 through regional public health networks.

16 4 Effective Date.

17 I. Paragraphs VI and XIX of section 3 of this act shall take effect January 1, 2026.

18 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
