AN ACT                   relative to animal chiropractors.

COMMITTEE:       Executive Departments and Administration

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ANALYSIS

This bill exempts individuals with degrees in veterinary medicine or chiropractics who have completed a nationally recognized animal chiropractic program, as determined by the executive director of the office of professional licensure and certification, from veterinary licensure requirements.

AN ACT                      relative to animal chiropractors.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 New Hampshire Veterinary Practice Act; License Required and Exceptions. Amend RSA 332-  
2 B:2 by inserting after paragraph X the following new paragraph:

3            XI. Animal chiropractic practice by an individual with a doctorate of veterinary medicine  
4 (DVM) or a doctor of chiropractic (DC) degree, and who has completed a nationally recognized  
5 animal chiropractic program as determined by the executive director in accordance with rules  
6 adopted pursuant to RSA 541-A and in consultation with the board of veterinary medicine and the  
7 board of chiropractic examiners.

8            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
