8 IV. Pursuant to RSA 193:3, VI, a school board may execute a contract with any approved
9 ~~[nonsectarian private]~~ **nonpublic** school approved by the school board as a school tuition program as
10 defined in RSA 193:3, VII to provide for the education of a child who resides in the school district,
11 and may raise and appropriate money for the purposes of the contract, if the school district does not
12 have a public school at the pupil's grade level and the school board decides it is in the best interest of
13 the pupil.
