**EDUCATION FINANCE**

**HB 366-FN-A**, modifying the priority of applications for school building aid grants.

Inexpedient to Legislate, Vote 6-0.

Senator Keith Murphy for the committee.

This bill removes the prioritization of school construction project applications that received insufficient funds in the previous fiscal year and applications with critical needs over newer applications. The prime sponsor, Rep. Michael Cahill, testified to the Education Finance Committee that he opposed this bill because it was substantially amended by the House. Therefore, the committee approved the ITL motion.
