This bill requires health insurance policies to provide coverage for adult prosthetics, including activity-specific prosthetic devices. Current law requires such coverage for children's prosthetics. The Senate Finance Committee amended SB 408-FN to apply this additional coverage to the State of New Hampshire's Employee Health Benefit Plan under RSA 21-I. It also moves the effective date from January 1, 2027 to January 1, 2028.
