SB 640-FN, relative to the use of artificial intelligence to provide services requiring a professional license.

Ought to Pass with Amendment, Vote 4-0.

Senator Howard Pearl for the committee.

SB 640-FN prohibits the use of Artificial Intelligence to provide services that require a professional license. The bill permits the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification to collect fees when enforcing this and establishes the framework for how Artificial Intelligence may be used by licensed professionals in their practice. The amendment narrows the original bill's focus to unlicensed practice and the use of Artificial Intelligence. It also establishes a commission to review the implementation of this statute, so as to understand its effect.
