Floor Amendment to HB 377-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

2

3 AN ACT relative to health care professionals administering hormone treatments and puberty  
4 blockers and creating a private right of action for violation of the chapter.

6 Amend RSA 332-N as inserted by section 2 of the bill by inserting after 332-N:2 the following new  
7 section:

9 332-N:3 Private Right of Action.

10 I. A minor aggrieved by a violation of this chapter may bring an action in the superior court  
11 for damages and injunctive relief against any person who has committed a violation of this chapter.

12 II. An individual under 18 years of age may bring an action during their minority through a  
13 parent or next friend, or may bring an action in their own name upon reaching majority. A person  
14 shall bring a claim for a violation of this chapter no later than 2 years after the minor aggrieved by  
15 violation of this chapter reaches the age of majority.

16 III. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an action under this chapter may be  
17 commenced, and relief may be granted, in a judicial proceeding without regard to whether the person  
18 commencing the action has sought or exhausted available administrative remedies.

19 IV. Notwithstanding RSA 507-E or any other provision of law, the plaintiff may recover  
20 damages for all injuries, including but not limited to any costs incurred for any subsequent  
21 procedures, therapies, prescriptions, or other treatments related to the unlawful medical procedure  
22 or treatment.

23 V. In any action or proceeding to enforce a provision of this chapter, a prevailing party who  
24 establishes a violation of this chapter shall recover reasonable attorneys' fees.

25 VI.(a) The attorney general shall have authority to bring suit to enforce compliance with this  
26 chapter.

27 (b) This chapter shall not be construed to deny, impair, or otherwise affect any right or  
28 authority of the attorney general, the State of New Hampshire, or any agency, officer, or employee of  
29 the state, acting under any law other than this chapter, to institute or intervene in any proceeding.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill prohibits the performance of a medical procedure or the prescription or issuance of medication, upon or to a minor child, that is intended to alter the minor child's gender. The bill also creates a private right of action against a person who commits a violation of the chapter.
