Amendment to HB 1308-FN

1 Amend RSA 265:54, I-a as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

2

3 I-a. Testimony under oath from the school bus driver or other witness that a vehicle failed to
4 stop and remain stopped as required by paragraph I shall be sufficient evidence to prove that the
5 owner of the vehicle was driving and has violated the provisions of paragraph I, unless such evidence
6 is rebutted or contradicted. ***The camera footage from the bus may be used as evidence to***
7 ***identify the vehicle owner or operator and shall be made available by subpoena to law***
8 ***enforcement and the county attorney. Any video recording shall be used for the sole***
9 ***purpose of supplementing observations and sworn statements of a school bus driver or***
10 ***operator, including for purposes of identification of vehicles and operators responsible for***
11 ***school bus law violations. The owner of a vehicle cited for a school bus law violation shall***
12 ***also have access to the recording or to a copy of the recording, if requested.***

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill increases penalties for unlawfully passing a stopped school bus, authorizes bus camera footage as identification evidence, and mandates license suspension for first and repeat offenses.
