Floor Amendment to SB 625-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT establishing a committee to study options for family members of intentional homicide
4 victims where the department of justice does not file charges in a case and removing
5 Hepatitis B from the list of diseases for which immunization is required under state

8 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 5 with the following:

10 6 Immunization Requirements; Hepatitis B Removed. Amend RSA 141-C:20-a, I to read as
11 follows:

12 I. All parents or legal guardians shall have their children, who are residing in this state,
13 immunized against diphtheria, mumps, pertussis, poliomyelitis, rubella, rubeola, tetanus, varicella,
14 [~~Hepatitis B,~~] and Haemophilus influenzae type B (Hib).

15 7 Effective Date.

16 I. Section 6 of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

17 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
