

1 Committee of Conference Report on SB 429-FN-A, relative to the placement of trauma kits in public

4 Recommendation:

5 That the Senate recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the House amendment, and  
6 concur with the House amendment, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as passed by the  
8 House, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend the bill by replacing section 4 with the following:

11

12 4 Education; Parental Bill of Rights. RSA 189-B:4, I(p) is repealed and reenacted to read as  
13 follows:

14 (p) To consent in writing before the state or any of its political subdivisions, including  
15 any school pursuant to RSA 189:68, III–V, makes a video or voice recording, unless such recording is  
16 made during or as part of a court proceeding; part of a forensic interview in a criminal or child  
17 protective services investigation; solely for the purpose of a safety demonstration, including the  
18 maintenance of order and discipline in common areas of a school or on student transportation  
19 vehicles; as a component of the administration of a required assessment; of a school-sponsored event  
20 that is open to the general public; as part of the regular instructional coursework required by the  
21 school; or as part of instruction in a student journalism, media production, or broadcasting course or  
22 school-sponsored extracurricular activity that has been approved by the local school board or board  
23 of trustees.
