Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

10 general ~~[council]~~ **counsel**

11 2 Repeal. RSA 2024, 296:6, I, relative to the prospective repeal of the phase-in schedule for
12 appointment of counsel, is repealed.

13 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
