SENATE BILL **507**

AN ACT relative to the financial obligation of a school district concerning students expelled for committing assault against a school staff member.

ANALYSIS

This bill limits a school district's financial obligations to the continuing education of an expelled pupil to the average cost-per-pupil where the pupil is expelled as the result of committing an assault against a school staff member.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Suspension and Expulsion of Pupils; School District Financial Obligation
2 Amended. Amend RSA 193:13 by inserting after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

3 II-a.(a) A school district's financial obligation in continuing the education of a pupil expelled
4 as the result of the commission of an assault against a school staff member shall be limited to the
5 average cost-per-pupil for that district.

6 (b) Nothing in this paragraph shall negate the responsibility of the parent to educate the
7 pupil.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
