STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT establishing a study committee to study the issue of school bullying.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study school bullying.

2 2 Membership and Compensation.

3 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

4 (a) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

5 (b) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
6 house of representatives.

7 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
8 the duties of the committee.

9 3 Duties. The committee shall study school bullying and means to prevent it.

10 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
11 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named senate
12 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
13 section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

14 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
15 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
16 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2026.

17 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
