This bill modifies how insurance companies can claim tax credits for assessments paid to the NH Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association in an effort to limit large, unpredictable revenue losses in years with high assessments. It further clarifies when credits can be taken and that the credits cannot be carried forward. HB 1194-FN also includes housekeeping language as it pertains to the conduct of a sports book, or participation in sports wagering authorized by RSA 287-I.
