HB 1109 outlines procedures for handling the suspension of certain state and local employees by providing written notice and periodic updates. The amendment clarifies language of the underlying bill, ensuring there is written notice provided when a suspension of a public employee occurs, however provides that this is not done in a manner which may prejudice the case. Additionally, the Nongermane amendment codifies that certain positions in the department of corrections are in group II retirement system status. While this has been the case, and the incumbents have been paying into the group II retirement system, this amendment codifies the practice for clarity.
