This bill provides for new mechanisms for the enforcement of criminal restitution obligations, including mandatory financial reevaluation and additional penalties for noncompliance. Due to Governor and Executive Council approval of a contract for a new restitution management system, the requirements of HB 1576-FN can be absorbed within existing Department of Corrections' resources. There is no expected fiscal impact to state revenues or expenditures.
