STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT defining the cost of an adequate education.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Education; Adequate Public Education; Cost of an Adequate Education. Amend RSA 193-E:2-
2 b, I to read as follows:

3 I. The general court shall use the definition of the opportunity for an adequate education in
4 RSA 193-E:2-a to determine the resources necessary to provide essential programs, considering
5 educational needs. The general court shall make an initial determination of the necessary specific
6 resource elements to be included in the opportunity for an adequate education. ***The specific***
7 ***resource elements necessary to provide the substantive educational content of an adequate***
8 ***education shall include: teachers, principals, administrative assistants, guidance***
9 ***counselors, library/media specialists, technology coordinators, custodians, nurses,***
10 ***instructional supplies, technology, professional development, facilities operations and***
11 ***maintenance, and transportation.***

12 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
