House Bill 1492-FN, as amended by the House, extends the time to appeal towing and impoundment fees, requires invoices to include notice of appeal rights, and prohibits the Division of Motor Vehicles from suspending a driver's license for unpaid towing or storage fees owed to a private entity. The Committee amendment retains these provisions and further revises procedures governing the state police tow list, including requirements for tow businesses and employees, disciplinary processes, and operational standards for participation.
