HOUSE BILL **1277**

AN ACT relative to proof of identification on absentee ballot applications.

ANALYSIS

This bill requires an applicant for an absentee ballot to write his or her drivers' license number or nondrivers' license identification number on their application.

AN ACT relative to proof of identification on absentee ballot applications.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Forms; Drivers' License Number Included. Amend RSA 657:4, I to read as follows:

2 I. Prior to any state election, the secretary of state shall prepare the appropriate application
3 forms for absentee ballots worded in substantially the following form. The secretary of state shall
4 insert the names of all parties qualified as set forth in RSA 652:11 in the list of parties on the
5 application form. The secretary of state shall prepare the application forms in such quantity as he or
6 she deems necessary:

7 Absence (Excluding Absence Due to Residence Outside the United States), Religious Observance,
8 and Disability:

9 I hereby declare that (check one):

10 I am a duly qualified voter who is currently registered to vote in this town/ward.

11 I am absent from the town/city where I am domiciled and will be until after the next election,
12 or I am unable to register in person due to a disability, and request that the forms necessary for
13 absentee voter registration be sent to me with the absentee ballot.

14 I will be entitled to vote by absentee ballot because (check one):

15 I plan to be absent on the day of the election from the city, town, or unincorporated place
16 where I am domiciled.

17 I am confined in a penal institution for a misdemeanor or while awaiting trial.

18 I am requesting a ballot for the presidential primary election and I may be absent on the day
19 of the election from the city, town, or unincorporated place where I am domiciled, but the date of the
20 election has not been announced. I understand that I may only make such a request 14 days after
21 the filing period for candidates has closed, and that if I will not be absent on the date of the election I
22 am not eligible to vote by absentee ballot.

23 I cannot appear in public on election day because of observance of a religious commitment.

24 I am unable to vote in person due to a disability.

25 I cannot appear at any time during polling hours at my polling place because of an
26 employment obligation. For the purposes of this application, the term "employment" shall include
27 the care of children and infirm adults, with or without compensation.

28 For use only on the Monday immediately prior to the election: I cannot appear at my polling place
29 on election day because the National Weather Service has issued a winter storm warning, blizzard
30 warning, or ice storm warning for election day applicable to my city, town, or unincorporated place
31 and either (check one):

1 ____ I am elderly or infirm or I have a physical disability, and would otherwise vote in person but I
2 have concerns for my safety traveling in the storm.

3 ____ I anticipate that school, child care, or adult care will be canceled, and would otherwise vote in
4 person but will need to care for children or infirm adults.

5 Any person who votes or attempts to vote using an absentee ballot who is not entitled to vote by
6 absentee ballot shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. RSA 657:24.

1 Signature _____ Print Name _____

2 If your absentee ballot application or affidavit envelope has the printed name and signature of a
3 person who assisted you with voting, your signature will not be compared to your signature on the
4 absentee ballot affidavit to verify your identity. Otherwise, if your signatures do not appear to be
5 made by the same person, your absentee ballot may not be counted.

6 The applicant must sign this form to receive an absentee ballot. Any person who witnesses and
7 assists a voter with a disability in executing this form shall print and sign his or her name in the
8 space provided on the application form. The moderator will not compare the voter's signature on the
9 application with the signature on the absentee ballot affidavit when a person assisting the voter has
10 signed the statement on the absentee ballot application or affidavit envelope that assistance was
11 provided.

12 2 Verification of Absentee Ballot Applicant. Amend RSA 657:17-c, I to read as follows:

13 I. Every applicant for an absentee ballot shall provide verification before being issued an
14 absentee ballot. Verification shall be satisfied by one of the following methods:

15 (a) Including a copy of the voter's photo identification with the absentee ballot
16 application. The identification shall meet the requirements of RSA 659:13, II(a);

17 (b) Including a notarized signature on the absentee ballot application form; [ø]

18 (c) ***Including a New Hampshire drivers' license number or nondriver's***
19 ***identification number on the absentee ballot request form that the town clerk or their***
20 ***designee can use to verify the identity of the absentee ballot applicant with the New***
21 ***Hampshire division of motor vehicles; or***

22 (d) Personally presenting a qualifying photo identification, as defined in RSA 659:13,
23 II(a), to the city or town clerk or their designee prior to the issuance of the absentee ballot.

24 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
