HOUSE BILL **1300**

AN ACT changing the state's congressional districts.

SPONSORS: Rep. Ankarberg, Straf. 7; Sen. Innis, Dist 7

COMMITTEE: Election Law

AN ACT changing the state's congressional districts.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 U.S. Representative Districts. RSA 662:1 is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

2 662:1 U.S. Representative Districts. The state is divided into 2 districts for the choosing of
3 representatives in the congress of the United States. Each district may elect one representative.
