AN ACT                    restricting abortion providers from the definition of charitable organization for the purposes of games of chance.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 Charitable Organization; Definition. Amend the introductory paragraph of RSA 287-D:1,  
2 IV(a) to read as follows:

3            IV.(a) "Charitable organization" means any bona fide religious, charitable, civic, veterans',  
4 or fraternal or church organization, including police and firemen's organizations and houses of  
5 worship which shall have been registered with the secretary of state for at least one year, and in  
6 existence and organized under the laws of this state for at least one year in a town or city in this  
7 state. ***For purposes of this section, "charitable organization" shall not include an abortion***  
8 ***provider.*** To be eligible for licensure under this chapter, a charitable organization shall do all of the  
9 following:

10           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
