HOUSE BILL **1370**

AN ACT relative to the reporting requirements for the identification and accommodation of gifted and talented students.

ANALYSIS

This bill removes the requirement that public schools submit to the department of education an annual report informing the department that it has no policies to identify and accommodate gifted students.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to the reporting requirements for the identification and accommodation of gifted and talented students.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Education; Reports; Identification and Accommodation of Gifted and Talented Students.

2 Amend RSA 189:29-b, II to read as follows:

3 II. Beginning in the [~~2022-2023~~] **2026-2027** school year, every New Hampshire public school
4 shall submit to the department of education, no later than August 1, an annual narrative report
5 detailing the policies, programs, and procedures that are in place to identify and accommodate the
6 unique needs of gifted and talented students. [~~If no such policies, programs, or procedures exist, the
7 report shall so state.~~]

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
