House Bill 1665, as amended by the House, grants all parties to an administrative proceeding equal authority to subpoena witnesses and documents, using the same subpoena authority provided under RSA 516:2 through RSA 516:5. The Committee recommends the bill be referred to Interim Study after raising concerns regarding which administrative proceedings and municipal quasi-judicial hearings would be affected, and whether the subpoena procedures should be more clearly incorporated within RSA 541-A.
