This bill would direct the Department of Revenue Administration to participate in the federal income tax credit for contributions of individuals to qualified scholarship granting organizations; direct the Department of Education to create a qualifying scholarship granting organizations list; and direct the Governor to approve workforce training programs for federal Workforce Pell Grants. HB 1774-FN would not result in additional administrative costs as both the revenue and expenditure impacts were indeterminable.
