AN ACT                establishing the first-in-the-nation security task force to coordinate planning for presidential campaign events.

ANALYSIS

This bill establishes the first-in-the-nation security task force to coordinate security planning for campaign events related to the 2028 presidential election.

**- Page 2 -**

1 (c) Identify training, communications, and resource needs, including interoperable  
2 communications and de-escalation best practices;

3 (d) Conduct outreach to recognized student organizations and institutions regarding  
4 rights and responsibilities on campuses; and

5 (e) Produce a comprehensive recommended first-in-the-nation (FITN) security plan for  
6 the 2028 cycle.

7 V. The task force shall meet at the call of the chair and at least quarterly through June 30,  
8 2028. A majority of appointed members constitutes a quorum. Members shall serve without  
9 compensation but may receive mileage at the state rate.

10 VI.(a) The task force shall report its initial guidance under paragraph IV to the speaker of  
11 the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house clerk, the senate clerk, the  
12 governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2026.

13 (b) A draft FITN security plan shall be delivered to the speaker of the house of  
14 representatives, the president of the senate, the house clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the  
15 state library no later than September 1, 2027.

16 (c) An after-action report evaluating the plan's implementation shall be delivered to the  
17 speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house clerk, the senate  
18 clerk, the governor, and the state library no later than June 30, 2028, with recommendations for  
19 future cycles.

20 2 Prospective Repeal. RSA 21-P:72, and the subdivision heading preceding it, relative to the  
21 first-in-the-nation security task force, is repealed.

22 3 Effective Date.

23 I. Section 2 of this act shall take effect June 30, 2029.

24 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
