HOUSE BILL ***1693-FN***

AN ACT expanding the number of Grafton county commissioners.

ANALYSIS

This bill expands the number of Grafton county commissioners to 5 commissioners, assigns each commissioner a district, and provides for the election and terms therefor.

AN ACT expanding the number of Grafton county commissioners.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 County Commissioner Districts; Grafton County. RSA 662:4, V is repealed and reenacted to
2 read as follows:

3 V. Grafton: District 1, the towns of Hanover, Lyme, Orford, Piermont, Warren, and
4 Wentworth; District 2, the town of Enfield and the city of Lebanon; District 3, the towns of Bath,
5 Benton, Bethlehem, Easton, Franconia, Haverhill, Landaff, Lisbon, Littleton, Lyman, Monroe, and
6 Sugar Hill; District 4, the towns of Campton, Holderness, Lincoln, Plymouth, Thornton, Woodstock,
7 Waterville Valley, and the unincorporated place of Livermore; District 5, the towns of Alexandria,
8 Ashland, Bridgewater, Bristol, Canaan, Dorchester, Ellsworth, Grafton, Groton, Hebron, Orange,
9 and Rumney.

10 2 Elected for 2-Year Term; Grafton County. Amend RSA 653:1, VI(j) to read as follows:

11 (j) Grafton county-one county commissioner by the voters in each county commissioner
12 district; provided that, at the [~~2022 state general election, the commissioner from district 3 shall be~~
13 ~~elected to a 2-year term, the commissioner from district 1 shall be elected to a 4-year term and the~~
14 ~~commissioner from district 2 shall be elected to a 2-year term]~~ **2026 state general election, the**
15 **commissioners from districts 1 and 3 shall be elected to 2-year terms.** At each subsequent
16 state general election, [2] 5 commissioners shall be chosen in the county by the voters of the districts
17 [~~in which a commissioner's term is expiring; and, of the commissioners so chosen, one shall serve a 4-~~
18 ~~year term and one shall serve a 2-year term and both shall hold their offices until their successors~~
19 ~~are chosen and qualified. Following the 2022 state general election, the 4-year term shall be rotated~~
20 ~~in sequence starting with district 2]~~ **and shall be elected to 2-year terms.**

21 3 Application; Grafton County. The changes in Grafton county commissioner districts
22 established by this act shall not affect constituencies or terms of office of commissioners presently in
23 office. The commissioner districts established by this act shall be in effect for the purpose of electing
24 commissioners at the 2028 state general election. If there shall be a vacancy in a commissioner
25 district for any reason prior to the 2028 state general election, the vacancy shall be filled as provided
26 in law for Grafton county commissioners that existed for the most recent prior state general election.

27 4 Effective Date.

28 I. Section 1 of this act shall take effect January 1, 2028.

29 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

METHODOLOGY:

This bill adds two Grafton County commissioners and provides that all commissioners shall be elected to two-year terms.

The New Hampshire Association of Counties (NHAC) states that the additional two Grafton County Commissioners would increase expenditures by \$38,551.47 in FY 2028 and by an indeterminable amount each year thereafter. See the cost breakdown in the table below.
