STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT relative to the definition of hemp.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Hemp; Defintions. RSA 439-A:2, V is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:
- 2 V. "Hemp" means the plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the
- 3 seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers,
- 4 whether growing or not, with a delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3
- 5 percent on a dry weight basis. Total THC concentration shall include the sum of all THC, including
- 6 tetrahydrocannabinolic acid (THCA).
- 7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
