Amendment to HB 1095

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

2

3 AN ACT relative to the maximum weight of utility terrain vehicles.

5 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

7 1 Utility Terrain Vehicle; Maximum Weight. Amend RSA 215-A:1, XXIV to read as follows:

8 XXIV. "Utility terrain vehicle" means any mechanically propelled vehicle which is designed
9 or adapted for travel over surfaces other than maintained roads with one or more tires or tracks
10 equipped with a rollover protection system and/or safety belts, having capacity for passengers or
11 other payloads, not in excess of [~~2,000~~] **3,499** pounds unladen dry weight, and not to exceed 65
12 inches in overall width, excluding side mirrors. For purposes of this chapter, "utility terrain vehicle"
13 shall include but not be limited to side-by-side, ROV, gator, buggy, and OHV and abbreviated as
14 UTV, and all vehicles within this definition shall be classified as off highway recreational vehicles.

15 2 OHRV Weight On Certain Trails. Amend the introductory language of RSA 215-A:43, IV to
16 read as follows:

17 IV. No person shall operate an OHRV wider than 50 inches or over 1000 pounds on any
18 state-owned trails, except that no person shall operate an OHRV wider than 65 inches or over
19 [~~2,000~~] **3,499** pounds unladen dry weight on:

20 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2027.
