Floor Amendment to HR 35

1 Amend the resolution by replacing all after the title with the following:

3 Whereas, many atmospheric activities such as weather modification, stratospheric aerosol
4 injection (SAI), solar radiation modification (SRM), and other forms of geoengineering, involving the
5 intentional release of polluting emissions, harm human health and safety, the environment,
6 agriculture, wildlife, aviation, state security, and the economy of the state of New Hampshire; and

7 Whereas, it is the intention of the New Hampshire house of representatives to prohibit the
8 intentional injection, release, or dispersion, by any means, of chemicals, chemical compounds,
9 substances, or apparatus within the borders of this state into the atmosphere with the express
10 purpose of affecting temperature, weather, or the intensity of the sunlight, thereby prohibiting
11 geoengineering (including SAI and SRM) and other intentionally polluting activities in New
12 Hampshire's atmosphere and/or at ground level to preserve the safe, healthful, and peaceful uses of
13 New Hampshire's atmosphere for people, wildlife, and agriculture; and

14 Whereas, due to necessity arising from the federal stance and the potential and ease for enemies,
15 foreign and domestic, to cause harm intentionally, the states' rights, including their authorities, are
16 correctly exerted pursuant to the Tenth Amendment, where federal programs and restrictions have
17 become oppressive or destructive; now, therefore, be it

18 Resolved by the House of Representatives: the house hereby declares that no person shall
19 engage in geoengineering activities, including weather modification, stratospheric aerosol injection,
20 or solar radiation modification involving the intentional release of polluting emissions within the
21 borders of the state of New Hampshire.

22 Let it be further resolved that the House of Representatives recommends that the commissioner
23 of the department of environmental services, within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution,
24 provide notice of this policy to the following entities and also create a dedicated page on the
25 department of environmental services' website containing a copy of this resolution and copies of each
26 certified letter sent to the following entities:
