HOUSE BILL **1226**

AN ACT relative to restricting the issuance of identification documents by unauthorized individuals.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill limits the ability of the director of the division of motor vehicles to manufacture, advertise for sale, sell, or possess any fictitious, facsimile or simulated license to drive a motor vehicle to individuals who are U.S. citizens performing official duties under state or federal law.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Fictitious Drivers' Licenses. RSA 263:12, VI is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:
- 2 VI. Manufacture, advertise for sale, sell, or possess any fictitious, facsimile, or simulated
- 3 license to drive a motor vehicle unless specifically authorized by the director to provide such
- 4 document to an individual who is a United States citizen performing official duties under state and
- 5 federal law.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
