STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT designating the funds account for donations and bequests received by the department of military affairs and veterans services to be non-lapsing funds.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services. Amend RSA 110-B:1, III to read as
2 follows:

3 III. The department may receive, on behalf of the state, all donations and bequests made to
4 promote the welfare of military service members, veterans, and their families. ***These funds shall***
5 ***be nonlapsing and continually appropriated to the department.***

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
