AN ACT relative to the effects of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances on agriculture.

SPONSORS: Rep. W. Thomas, Hills. 12; Rep. N. Murphy, Hills. 12

COMMITTEE: Environment and Agriculture

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill grants immunity from civil liability to farmers for damages resulting from claims based on harms caused by certain per and poly fluorinated alkyl substances present in soil, water, or agricultural products. This bill also requires the department of environmental services to develop concentration-based standards for PFAS in biosolids at land-application sites.
