Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Education; Adequate Public Education; Cost of an Adequate Education. RSA 193-E:2-b is
2 repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

3 193-E:2-b Cost of an Adequate Education. The specific resource elements necessary to provide
4 the substantive educational content for an adequate education in RSA 193-E:2-a are teachers,
5 principals, administrative assistants, guidance counselors, library/media specialists, technology
6 coordinators, custodians, instructional supplies, technology, professional development, facilities
7 operations and maintenance, and transportation.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
