AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill permits a physician to perform breast surgery on a minor in certain instances if the procedure is at the election of the minor in consultation with her primary care physician.

AN ACT relative to breast surgeries for minors.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1       1 Limitations on Breast Surgeries for Minors; Exceptions to Prohibition. Amend RSA 329:53,  
2 II(d) and (e) to read as follows:

3               (d) The procedure is needed to correct gynecomastia and symptomatic macromastia; [or]

4               (e) Treatment of congenital deformities of the breast and/or chest wall[-]; **or**

5               ***(f) At the election of the minor in consultation with her primary care physician***  
6 ***when the primary reason for the breast reduction surgery is, but not limited to,***  
7 ***musculoskeletal pain, postural changes, or physical discomfort of the individual that***  
8 ***restricts exercise and activity.***

9       2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
