HOUSE BILL ***1157-FN***

AN ACT relative to licensure as a pet vendor.

ANALYSIS

This bill requires persons using physical facilities to transfer 30 or more animals to be licensed as a pet vendor.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT relative to licensure as a pet vendor.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Licensed Pet Vendors. Amend RSA 437:3 by inserting after paragraph IV the
2 following new paragraph:

3 IV-a. No physical facility shall be used by multiple people, firms, corporations, or other
4 entities, when the combined number of animals transferred exceeds 30 or more dogs, 30 or more
5 cats, 30 or more ferrets, or 50 or more birds or live animals customarily used as household pets,
6 unless one of the people, firms, corporations, or other entity is a licensed pet vendor.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 45 days after its passage.
