AN ACT relative to the maximum amount of terms an individual can serve on the electricians' board.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 61:1 Electricians; Board. Amend RSA 319-C:4, I and I-a to read as follows:

2 I. There shall be an electricians' board consisting of 5 members, including 2 master electricians,
3 one journeyman electrician, and 2 public members, each to be appointed by the governor, with the
4 approval of the council, to a term of 5 years. No member of the board shall be appointed to more than [2]
5 **3** terms. The state fire marshal or his designee shall be an ex officio member of the board, but shall not
6 vote in board determinations.

7 I-a. No member of the board shall serve more than [12] **16** years, including the time of [2] **3** 5-
8 year terms, being held over after a term expires, and fulfilling an unexpired term. Members' terms shall be
9 staggered and in no case shall any member's term coincide with another member's term. To avoid
10 coinciding terms, the next appointment for a member shall be for a term which complies with this
11 paragraph.

61:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
