Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Banks and Banking; Loan Associations; Credit Unions; Compensation. RSA 383-E:6-607(a) is
2 repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

3 (a) Any credit union may pay to each of the members of the board of directors, credit
4 committee, and supervisory committee for his or her services as a member of the board or committee
5 a sum that may, from time to time, be fixed by the members at an annual meeting. No officers,
6 directors, or employees shall receive any other compensation or fee for services provided to the credit
7 union beyond their compensation as officers, directors, or employees.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
