4 Recommendation:

5 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrency with the Senate amendment, and
6 concur with the Senate amendment, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
8 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend RSA 485-H:2, III as inserted by section 4 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

12 III. "Drinking water standard" means the (PFAS) maximum contaminant levels established
13 pursuant to RSA 485:16-e *or the PFAS National Primary Drinking Water Regulations in*
14 *accordance with 42 U.S.C. section 300g-1 if adopted by the commissioner for use in this*
15 *chapter. The standards established under RSA 485:16-e shall remain the operative*
16 *drinking water standard for all other purposes.*
