STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT repealing the directive that the state sell the Anna Philbrook Center for Children property in Concord.

2 repealed.

3 176:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
