AN ACT authorizing the department of military affairs and veterans services to license and lease property in which the department holds a property interest.

ANALYSIS

This bill:

I. Authorizes the department of military affairs and veterans services to lease or license property under its jurisdiction.

II. Clarifies that when department property is leased or licensed to private entities that are not exempt from taxation, the property is subject to local property taxes as though privately owned.

III. Outlines the responsibilities of lessees and licensees to pay taxes, the penalties for nonpayment, and the municipality's authority to enforce collection through liens and legal action.

IV. Establishes a dedicated property fund for the department.

AN ACT authorizing the department of military affairs and veterans services to license and lease property in which the department holds a property interest.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 257:1 New Paragraphs; National Guard Facilities. Amend RSA 110-B:28 by inserting after paragraph
2 VI the following new paragraphs:

3 VII. The department of military affairs and veterans services shall have the authority to license or
4 lease all property under its jurisdiction.

5 VIII. All department property that is leased or licensed by a person, other than by the department
6 or any other entity exempted from taxation under RSA 72:23, shall include in the lease or other agreement
7 the terms providing for the payment of properly assessed real and personal property taxes by the party
8 using or occupying said property under the provisions of RSA 72:23.

9 257:2 New Section; Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services Fund. Amend RSA 110-B
10 by inserting after section 28-a the following new section:

11 110-B:28-b Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services Property Fund.

12 I. There is hereby established in the office of the state treasurer a fund to be known as the
13 department of military affairs and veterans services property fund, which shall be kept distinct and
14 separate from all other funds. The fund shall consist of such moneys as may be appropriated to the
15 department for each fiscal year relating to department property, department projects, or any activity of the
16 department, as well as any gifts, grants, or donations received for such purpose. All moneys in the
17 department of military affairs and veterans services property fund shall be nonlapsing and continually
18 appropriated to the department.

19 II. Moneys credited to the fund may be expended by the department for the benefit of the
20 department:

21 (a) To purchase, lease, acquire, own, improve, use, sell, convey, transfer, or otherwise deal
22 in and with department property, department projects, or any interest therein, whether tangible or
23 intangible, as authorized under this chapter.

24 (b) To pay the costs of operating, maintaining, improving, and repairing department property
25 and department projects.

26 (c) To pay all administrative and operational expenses of the department authorized by law,
27 including, but not limited to, wages, salaries, benefits, reasonable overhead expenses, and expenses
28 allocated by law or authorized by the adjutant general, including any allocation or reimbursement to other
29 department or authority funds, as permitted by law.

1 (d) To pay the principal of, and premium, if any, and the interest on any outstanding bonds of
2 the state related to department property or department projects, as such obligations become due and
3 payable.

4 (e) To create and maintain reserves as required by any bond resolution or security document
5 relating to such bonds.

6 (f) To pay any payments in lieu of taxes required by law, if any, related to department
7 property or department projects.

8 (g) To pay any and all other expenses incident to the management and operation of the
9 department, its property, or its projects in furtherance of its statutory purposes.

10 III. Money in this fund shall be paid out on manifests approved by the governor and council in the
11 same manner as other state claims are paid, provided that advances may be made to the treasurer of the
12 department as requested and approved pursuant to this section. Manifests covering advances shall be
13 submitted at the earliest practicable time for regular processing and audit as required by law.

14 IV. The department revenues or any other revenues, other than revenues from or associated with
15 the department property or the department projects, received and due to the department shall be retained
16 by the department and shall be used for the department property or the department projects in such
17 manner as the adjutant general may determine consistent with the provisions of this section or as is
18 otherwise provided by law or by the terms and conditions incident to any gift, grant, devise, bequest, trust,
19 or security document.

22 subparagraph:

23 (411) Moneys deposited in the department of military affairs and veterans services
24 property fund established in RSA 110-B:28-b.
