This bill requires that at any session of the general court or during any hearing of a committee of the general court, there shall be a minimum 10 minute break for every 3 continuous hours of proceedings.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 New Section; Breaks During Legislative Proceedings. Amend RSA 14 by inserting after  
2 section 14-c the following new section:

3            14:14-d Breaks During Legislative Proceedings.

4            At any session of the general court or during any hearing of a committee of the general court,  
5 there shall be a minimum 10 minute break for every 3 continuous hours of proceedings.

6            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
