AN ACT                    relative to a parent's access to their minor child's library records.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 New Paragraph; Library User Records; Confidentiality; Access to Library Records of Minors.

2 Amend RSA 201-D:11 by inserting after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

3            II-a. All library records related to a minor's current borrowing of printed library materials  
4 and audio-visual materials, such as DVDs and CDs, shall be available to the parent or legal  
5 guardian of the minor when requested by the parent or legal guardian whose address matches that  
6 on the minor's library account.

7            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
